

MARTON PUBLIC SCHOOL

AGREEMENT FOR STUDENTS USING THE INTERNET

RATIONALE:

As a general policy, the staff of Marton Public School support equity of access to both information and information technology.

UNDESIRABLE SITES:

Our service provider has a dedicated server that all Department of Education Internet computers have to go through to get Internet access. This restricts undesirable sites from student access.

SUPERVISION:

A member of staff will supervise all students using the Internet. No student is permitted to access the Internet unless supervised by a member of staff.

GUIDELINES:

Students using the on-line services must:

- 1. Abide by the rules for going on-line, as specified by the supervising teacher.
- 2. Select only socially acceptable material.
- 3. Not give out any personal information such as my name, address, telephone number, parent's work and telephone number or name and location of school.
- 4. Only visit the sites designated by the supervising teacher
- 5. **Email** Students will be given a Department of Education filtered WEB BASED email account. When using email at home or at school they must:
 - i) Use only appropriate messages and attachments.
 - ii) Not change their password unless approval is granted by the school.
 - iii) Keep their password secure and private
- 6. If using a USB storage device students must scan this device for viruses when using school computers.

ANY INAPPROPRIATE USE MAY RESULT IN THE CANCELLATION OF THIS EMAIL ACCOUNT AND COMPUTER PRIVILEGES BEING WITHDRAWN.
